Linking

RULE:

If one word <u>ends</u> in a **consonant** sound, and the next word begins with a **vowel** sound, LINK.

Example: ls_Ann_around?

Should_I get_a coffee for_her?

Sometimes the [h] is dropped at the beginning of words such as him, her, his, he.

Example: Tell_him_l'll call_him after_he gets in.

RULE:

If one word <u>ends</u> in a **vowel**, and the next word <u>begins</u> with a **vowel**, LINK.

Example: Please say_it slowly.

She_always orders cappuccino.

Do you know_ her favourite donut?

RULE:

If one word <u>ends</u> with a **continuant consonant (not a stop)**, and the next word begins with a **similar sound**, LINK.

Example: Call later.

Can I please_speak to Will?

Does_she miss_school often?

Do they have vanilla?

RULE:

If one word <u>ends</u> with a **stop consonant** [p t k b d g] and the next word <u>begins</u> with a **consonant**, the stop sound will be "unreleased", and the sounds will blend together.

Example: I ordered_two chocolate_donuts.

If the sounds are the same, you will only say it once.

Example: Speak carefully.

He's an odd duck.
